Living Treasure Award recognizes an individual artist from Brown, Greene, Lawrence, Monroe or Owen counties for lifetime achievement in visual, literary or performing arts.

When will the awards be presented?

Wednesday, February 21, 2007 at noon.

Who will make the decisions?

The BAAC will appoint a selection committee made up of local and regional arts supporters. Recipients will be notified in advance of the awards presentation.

This year's recipient will receive an original work of fiber art, commissioned by the BAAC and especially created by Daren Pitts Redman of Brown County.
